Monday Programs begin Monday, January 13, 2020. These are **8 week** programs and will end on Monday, March 9, 2020 (no class on Monday February 17, 2020 due to Family Day)

<u>Wednesday Programs</u> begin Wednesday, January 15, 2020. These are **8 week** programs and will end on Wednesday, March 4, 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: John Ross Robertson Public School (JRR) and its employees, are not affiliated with the After4 program. The After4 program is run by independent vendors working within the school, under individual vendor permits. A student monitor is on premises for the programs that are run from 3:45-4:45 pm. The student monitor is responsible for taking attendance and ensuring that all participants have left the building after the program is over. The wellbeing of the participants during all After4 programs is the responsibility of each individual vendor who assumes liability for every After4 participant. The liability is not on JRR or the student monitor.

PLEASE NOTE: It is a parent's responsibility to determine if AFTER 4 conflicts with your child's school team practices or other extra-curricular activities prior to registration. Please read the on-line agreement carefully – <u>refunds will not be given</u>.

IT IS THE POLICY OF AFTER 4 to allow one registration per child per time slot – i.e. one child cannot register for both Chocolate Workshop and Robotics on Monday – in order to allow the maximum number of children to register in a timely manner. Please finalize your registration choices before you go online.

All after school programs begin at 3:45pm and are one hour. A list of classrooms will be posted at the main school entrances and in the office prior to program start dates – please pick your child up from the appropriate classroom at 4:45pm.

For after school programs, please remind your child that he/she should go directly to the Staff Room at 3:35pm for AFTER 4 attendance. The program instructor will meet them in the Staff Room and take them to the appropriate room for their AFTER 4 program.

If your child is part of the <u>JRR Daycare</u> please remind them to go to the daycare after the bell rings as usual for daycare attendance and then they will be escorted to the Staff Room for After 4 attendance.

The program instructor will meet them in the Staff Room and take them to the appropriate room for their AFTER 4 program.

If you register your child for the <u>Lunch Program</u> please remind them to go to the lunchroom as usual and eat their lunch. Students should look to the corner of the gym closest to the stage/office for a sign "After 4 Lunch Program" and meet their instructor there for 12:05pm.

On-line registration will begin at <u>7:00 AM.</u>, Friday, December 13 2019 and continue until 7:30 p.m., Monday, December 30, 2019, or until a class is filled to its maximum capacity.

REGISTRATION WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED WITH:

- 1. A COMPLETED QUICK ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION, AND
- 2. <u>FULL ONLINE CREDIT CARD PAYMENT AT TIME OF REGISTRATION</u>. CHEQUES ARE NOT AN ACCEPTED FORM OF PAYMENT.

PLEASE NOTE THAT <u>NO REFUNDS</u> WILL BE ISSUED UNLESS A CLASS IS CANCELLED DUE TO LOW ENROLLMENT, SO YOU MUST ENSURE THERE ARE NO SCHEDULING CONFLICTS BEFORE YOU REGISTER.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. Unfortunately, we cannot offer space to all those who are interested each session.

If you are planning to register your child for a program, we advise that you visit www.quickenrollment.com in advance of the registration date if you have never created a family profile on the site before (i.e. for hockey or soccer programs, etc.). The system will store this information so you will not need to enter it in the future.

Here's how:

- 1. Go to www.quickenrollment.com. Enter "JRR" as the QuickWord and select "LEAGUES" from the drop box, then click GO.
- 2. Click on the third statement, that you have NEVER used QuickEnrollment to register on-line before.
- 3. The next page displays instructions on how to proceed. Click the <u>SETUP MAIN CONTACT</u> button at the bottom of the page.
- 4. Complete the Main Contact information then click "SUBMIT".
- 5. You will not see the Create Your Security Information page. Enter the security details, and set up a User ID and Password that you will use when registration during the registration week. PLEASE NOTE that the system will not accept an email address as a username because it does not recommend symbols. Pick a name that you will remember! Then click "SUMBIT".
- 6. You are now set up as the parent/guardian. Click "DONE" to move on to the next step.
- 7. You will now see your personal family profile with your name. Now it's time to add any children you will be registering. To start, click the "NO" button beside "Do ALL the participants you would like to register appear on the list below".
- 8. You will now see the "Add Participant to My Profile" page. Complete the information. Click the "Same address as Main Contact" tick box to pre-fill the address. Once complete click "SUBMIT".
- 9. You are done. Click the "CHANGE" button to edit or click "SUBMIT" to get to the Confirmation page. If you have another child to register, click "ADD ANOTHER PERSON" button. Otherwise, click "DONE".

When you enter the system on Registration day, you will enter the QuickWord "JRR" and select "LEAGUES" from the drop box and click "GO".

You will then have a list of the JRR AFTER 4 programs to choose from. If the program is not yet full, you will be prompted to choose the program one at a time for which you wish to register. If the program is already full, the system will let you know, or it will not appear in the list of choices. Once you have successfully registered, the system will prompt you for a credit card payment.
